Mrs. Hobart, Kin of Former Vice-President

MONTCLAIR, N. J., Sept. 10

(AP).—Mrs. Carolina Frye Hobart, eighty, daughter-in-law of former United States Vice-President Garret A. Hobart, died last night after a long illness. She lived at 56 Hyland Ave.

Her husband, Garret A. Hobart jr., who died in 1941, was a Passaic County park commissioner.

Her father-in-law was elected Vice-President in 1896 with William McKinley as President. The senior Hobart died in office three years later.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Catherine Hand and Mrs. Elizabeth Kingsbury, and a son, Garret A. Hobart III.
