PSC Introduces Development Fund General Council To Review Proposal

Tomorrow at 4:30 p.m. at a Special meeting of the S.G.A. General Council, a proposal for the formation of the Paterson State College Development Fund will be presented before the student representatives.

The Fund will supplement the present Building Program;

it will provide funds for recreational and social facilities and establish the college as a cultural center. Also, according to the discretion of the Board of Trustees, funds will be provided which contribute to the general development of the college.

With the support of the State of New Jersey, through the building program and expanded appropriations, the college has steered forward. However, public-supported institutions of higher learning must look toward private sources in addition to those resources provided by tuition and state appropriations.

The goals of the Development Fund would fall into these main categories:

1. To provide funds for supplementing the building program in order to include items of critical value to the college, which cannot be financed out of available building funds, such as:

(a) An electronic dinner system for the new auditorium.
(b) Air-conditioning for the new auditorium.
(c) Air-conditioning for the student dining hall.
(d) Closed-circuit TV installation in the new laboratory school.

2. To provide funds for the development of recreational and social facilities, such as:

(a) Tennis courts.
(b) Bleachers — 300 capacity for athletic field.
(c) A fully-developed college

center.

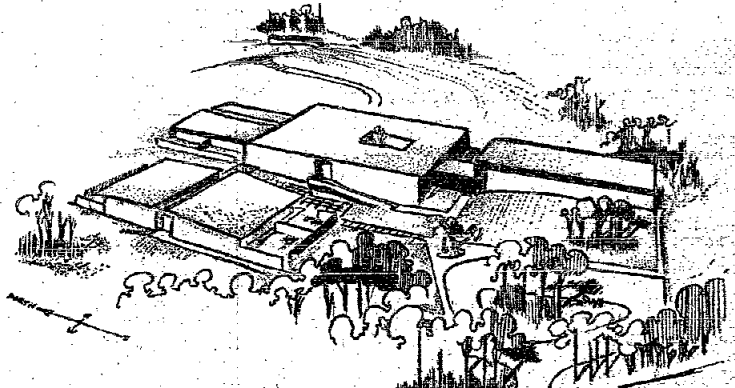
3. To provide funds for the development of the college as an area (See Proposal, Page 2)

New Fund Originates In Co-Op

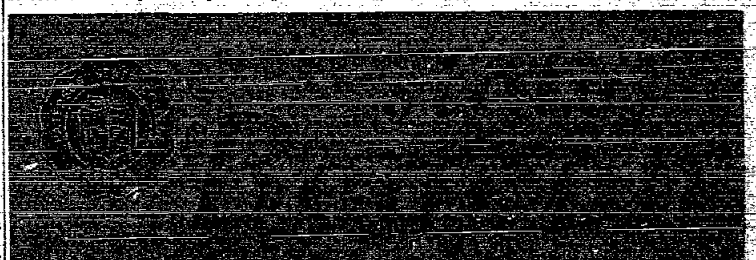
A fund amounting to \$595 was established at the October 11 meeting of the Student Co-Op. At the meeting a suggestion was made that representatives from the SGA, the Student Co-Op, the Faculty Association, and the College Administration meet to discuss the possibilities of the formation of a development fund for Paterson State College.

The representatives appointed a sub-committee comprised of the presidents of the various associations for the purpose of setting up goals. On November 12 the sub-committee decided that these goals fall into two main categories: short and long-term goals.

The short term goals consist of bleachers for the athletic field (See Co-Op, Page 2)

SGA President Speaks

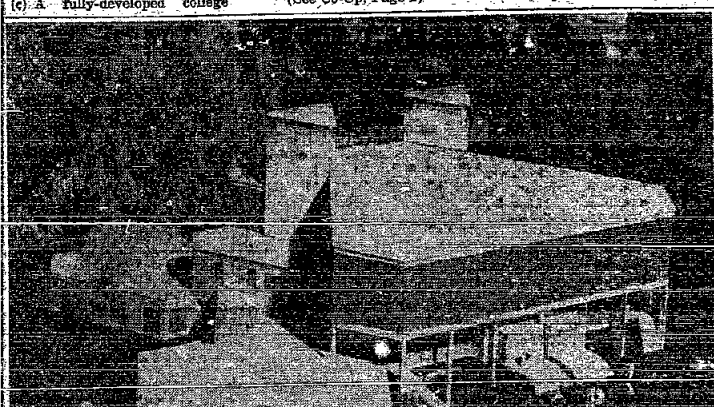

Tomorrow I hope to see the S.G.A. make a most important progressive step toward helping the College become the all-complete institution of higher learning that many far-seeing people have predicted it would become. We are going to vote to transfer approximately fifty thousand dollars from the present Permanent Reserve Fund to the new and vital College Development Fund. Because the Development Fund will be administered by a separate board which will include in its functions that of soliciting donations from industry, etc., this money will find better use than it is now put to, partially because it will "prime the pump" and encourage industries' investment in the college. It is expected that this new fund will not only grow in size but will be better geared to supplying needs of the college, due to its having its own board of trustees than the outmoded permanent reserve currently is.

Permanent Reserve consists of all unspent balances of the budgets of the S.G.A. administrations of more than fifteen years past and its intended use is for exactly what the College Development Fund is intended — that of supplying needs of the whole college that the state does not finance.

It is important to realize that this large capital reserve actually does not belong to present students although their representatives may vote to transfer it to a more useful account.

The birth of the Development Fund is an indication that the college is growing and is expected to grow much more. I now anticipate the day, and expect it will be soon, when the first piece of apparatus will appear on campus as a result of the S.G.A.'s vote to put to improved use the old Permanent Reserve.

Fund Successful At MSC

Paterson State College's Development Fund is not a new idea. Montclair State College and various other colleges have found that a Development Fund is invaluable to their growth.

At Montclair State College the Development Fund has made possible the following:

1. Professional stage in the auditorium.
2. Installation of an organ.
3. Purchase of permanent art ob-

jects and paintings.

4. Grants to faculty for study and publications of their work.

Such a fund enables the public to contribute to and support on-campus development that is not supported by the state. Since everyone — Board of Trustees, on- and off-campus groups, students, faculty, administration, and alumni — all have a "say" in this fund, it gives the college an extra control over its own progress.
