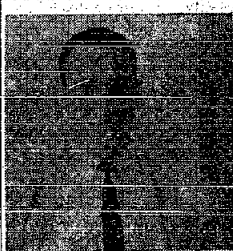
Junior Nominees

Gene Taub is a nominee for Student Government president. Gene, a sophomore biology major is a transfer student from UCLA where he was associated with the Student Honor Council.

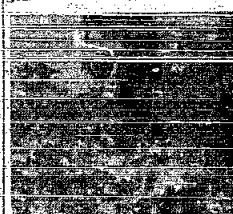

INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS: Move the red handle of the curtain back to the right and leave it there. Then, when the curtains are unhooked, the machine for voting will be visible. Turn down a pointer over the name of each candidate of your choice. After turning down all the pointers you desire, LEAVE THEM DOWN and move the red handle of the curtain back to the left as far as it will go, and leave it there. This records your vote, returns all pointers to their unvoted position, and hides the curtains.
