


# Pioneers Upset National Champs

Joining Rennar on the all-conference team were Bob Ebert, Steve Myers, Claudio Pirovano, Bolt Russo and Cesar Cuevas.























Other top players were Therese James



















# Baseball Season Shines With Personal & Team Accomplishments



Geimke a senior firstbaseman, shattered Dan Pasqua's career home run record by smacking nine this year for a career total of 42, eclipsing Pasqua's mark of 37 two years ago. The Gimp also broke Pasqua's records for most hits and runs scored in a career, is second all-time in runs batted in and his 354 lifetime average is sixth highest in WPC history.




























#### Pioneers Hit For Power And Average

























# Weather Cuts Into Season


























## Softball Enjoys Championship Season





Laurie Kearns, Gwen Masel and Ioliene Boenau headed the all-conference team.





















































New coach Dan Mecca may have inherited a small men's and women's track team but he sure got the most out of their.




































#### 38th Consecutive Winning Season Earns WPC National Attention



Coach Miller and the Pioneers were the leature of a WABC-TV special on women's athletics which aired on Channel 7 Feb. 20.

























# Women's Tennis
