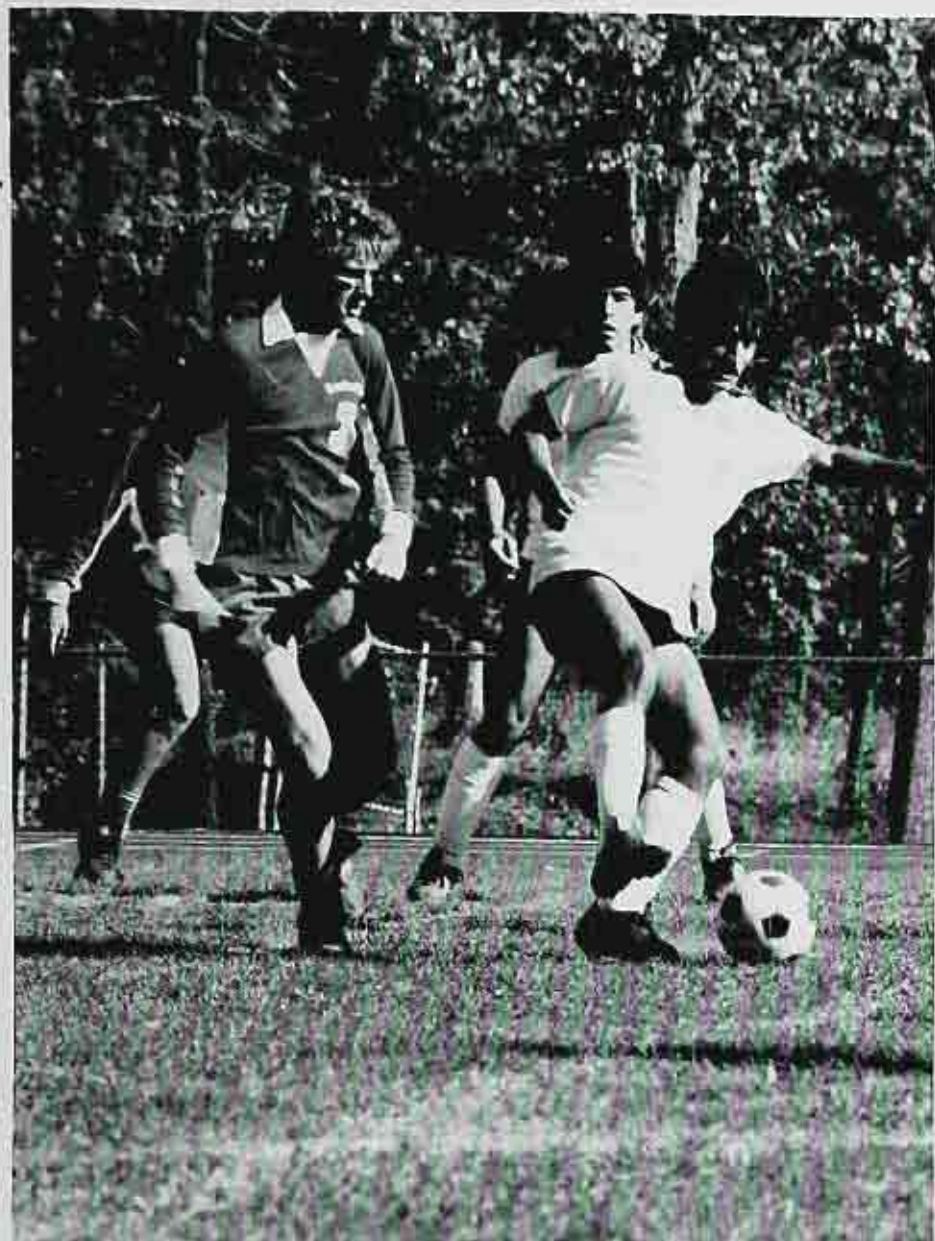
## Pioneers Upset National Champs

Freshman Sherry Patterson led the 9-14 Pioneers in scoring (13 points per game) and rebounding (13.0). An all-ECAC selection, Sherry was ninth in the country in rebounding.

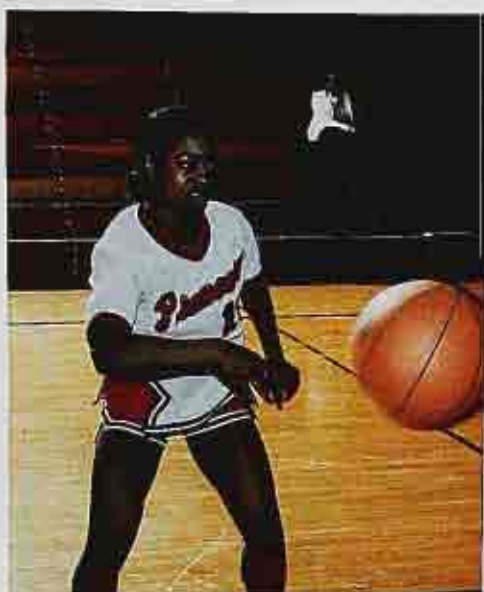
Other top players were Therese James

## A Second Championship And A New Home Highlight The Season

The Pioneers said farewell to Wightman Gym and hello to their new home, the \$4 million, 4,000-seat Recreation Center, en route to posting their second straight New Jersey State Athletic Conference championship. The team, 7-5 on Jan. 14, reeled off a school-record 14 consecutive victories including a 79-67 win at Montclair State on statewide television for the NJSAC title.

Receiving their fourth NCAA postseason tournament bid in five years, the team turned in its 10th consecutive winning season under coach John Adams with a 22-6 record. The 22 wins tied the school record.

Sharpshooting guard Andy King scored 17 points as the team defeated rival Montclair 70-63 before a packed house in Wightman Gym on Feb. 8. Not only did the game mark the Pioneer's finale in their old home, but it was the 500th win in the team's history.





## Pioneers Play On Game Of The Week

A record crowd of 2,377 turned out Feb. 13 as the Pioneers rolled over fourth-ranked Upsala 67-57 in the opening of the Rec. Center. The team, led by Donnie Forster, scored the game's first 10 points and never looked back in the contest that was New Jersey Network's TV Game of the Week.



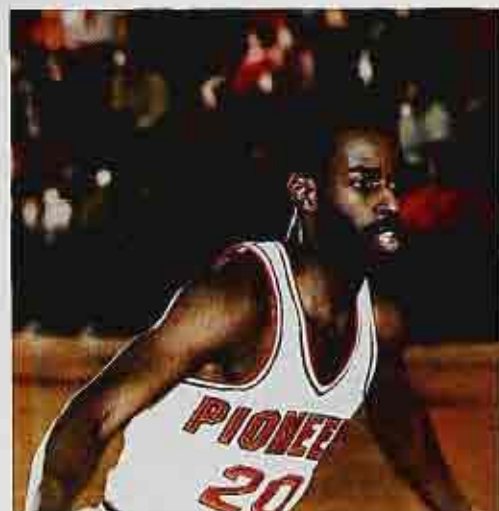
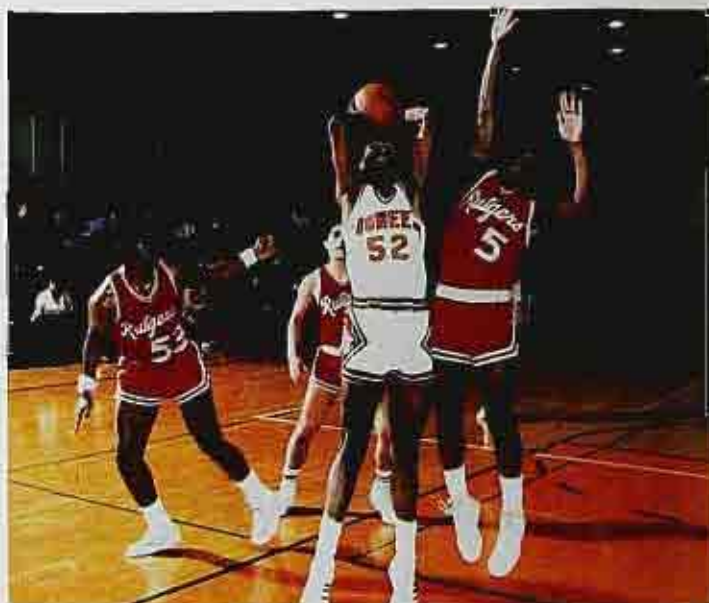






## Several Players Earned Individual Honors

## Baseball Season Shines With Personal & Team Accomplishments

Mark Geimke and Joe Lynch did what they do best — hit home runs and throw strikes — as the Pioneers enjoyed yet another outstanding season on the diamond. Geimke, a senior firstbaseman, shattered Dan Pasqua's career home run record by smacking nine this year for a career total of 42, eclipsing Pasqua's mark of 37 two years ago. The Gimp also broke Pasqua's records for most hits and runs scored in a career, is second all-time in runs batted in and his .354 lifetime average is sixth highest in WPC history.

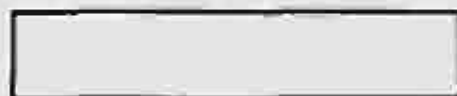
Lynch, the hardthrowing righthander,

broke the school record for most strikeouts in a career (194 in 240 innings) and most complete games. A junior, Joe has fashioned a career record of 21-8 and is second all-time in victories, appearances, innings pitched and earned run average.

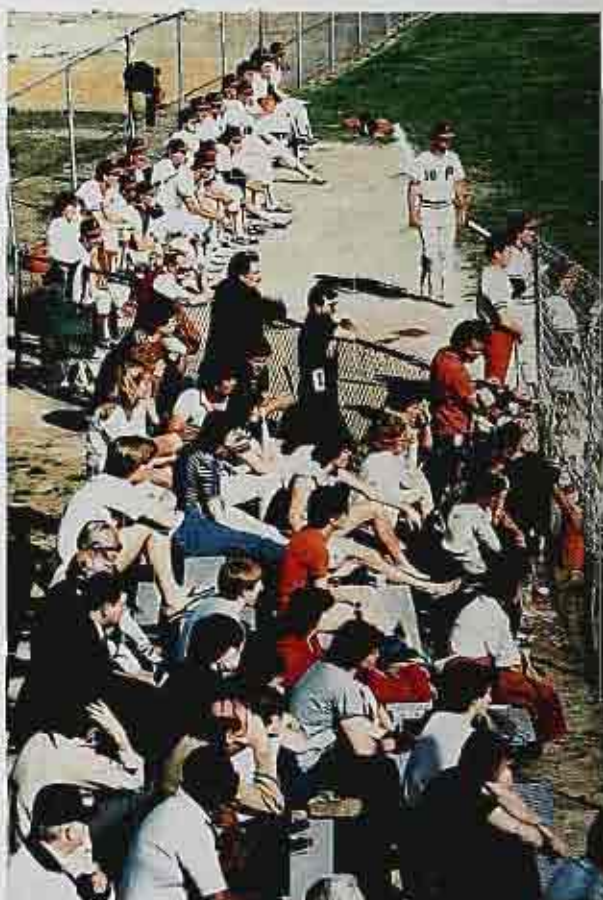
The Pioneers won the NJSAC Northern Division during the regular season and were 26-10 on the year. Wightman Field was the site for the NCAA Mid-Atlantic Regionals May 22-25 as the Pioneers advanced to the title game before bowing to eventual national champion Ramapo. It was the team's fourth straight trip to the NCAAs.















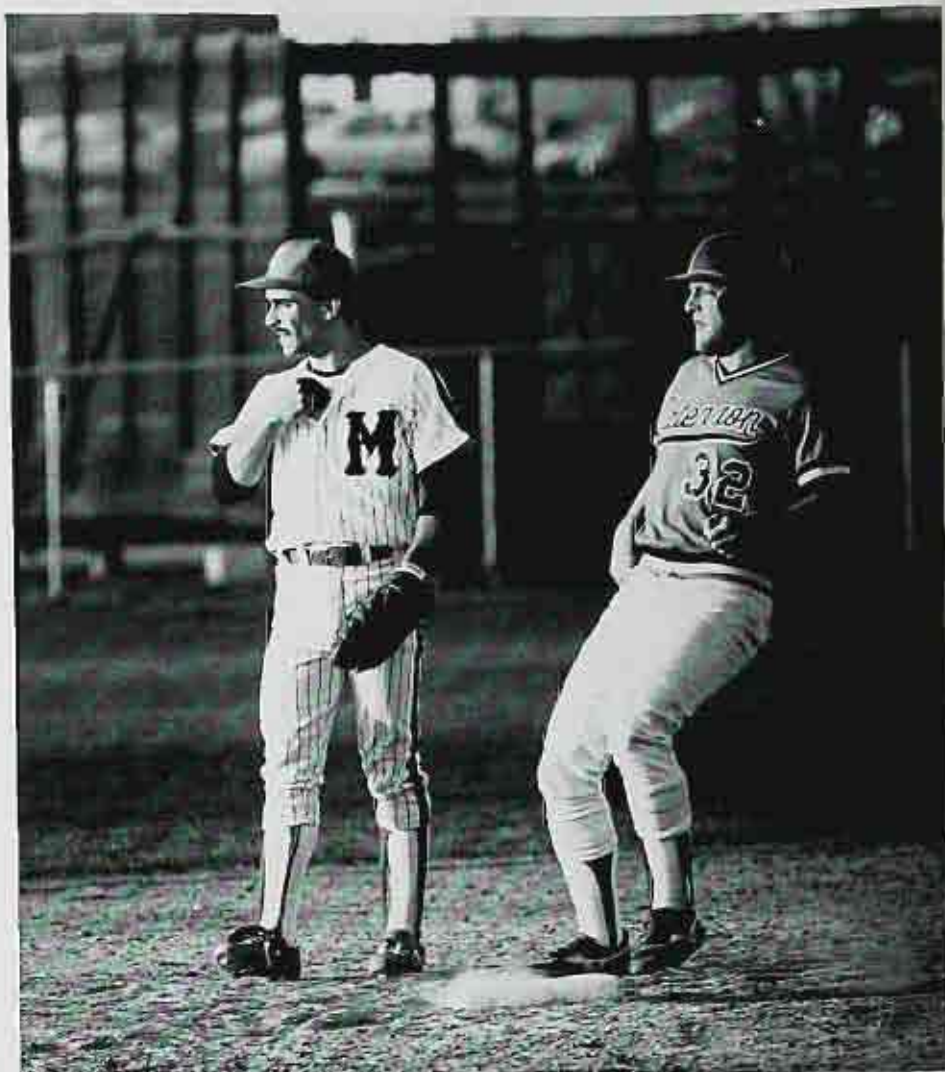


## Pioneers Hit For Power And Average

Coach Jeff Albies' team, which was ranked No. 3 in the country, dominated the all-state and all-star teams. Geimke, Lynch, secondbaseman Pat Byrnes, and catcher Bob Benkert were named to the all-state team, while Geimke, Lynch, Byrnes, Benkert, Steve Svenson, Chris Goldschrafe, Willie Baker and Tommaso D'Alberto were selected to the North-South all-star team.

Byrnes established school records for most hit-by-pitches in a season and career, and Goldschrafe hit safely in 19 consecutive games.

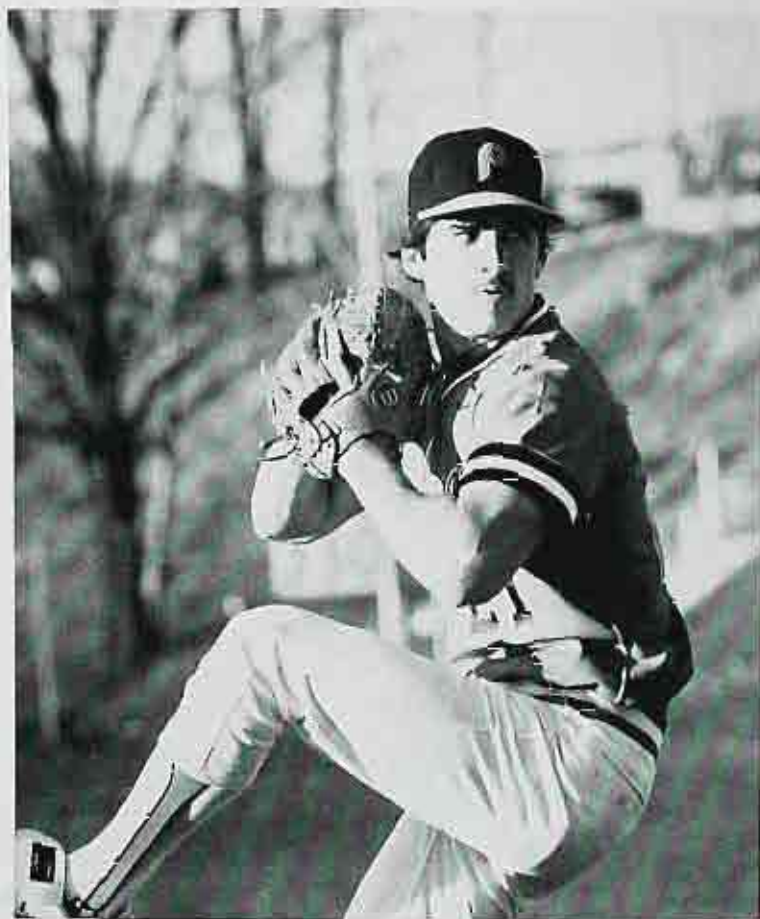

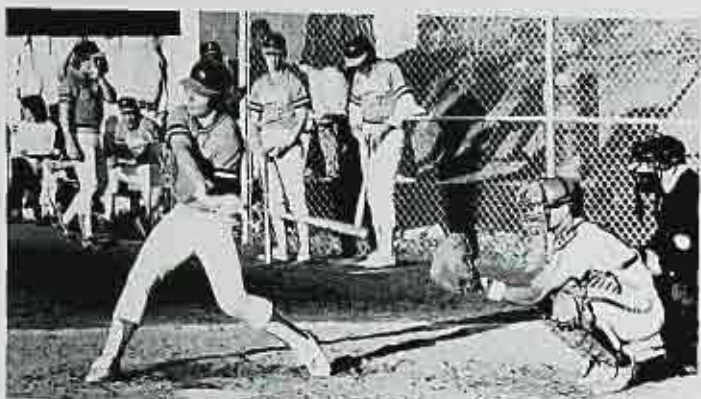

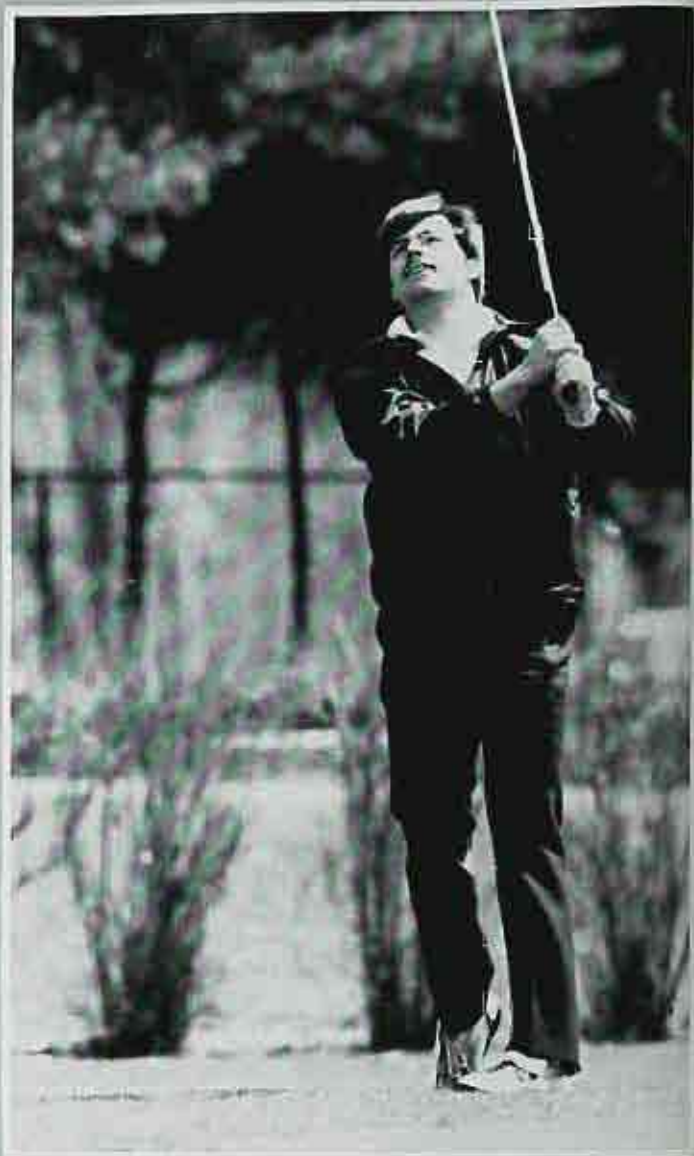
### Weather Cuts Into Season

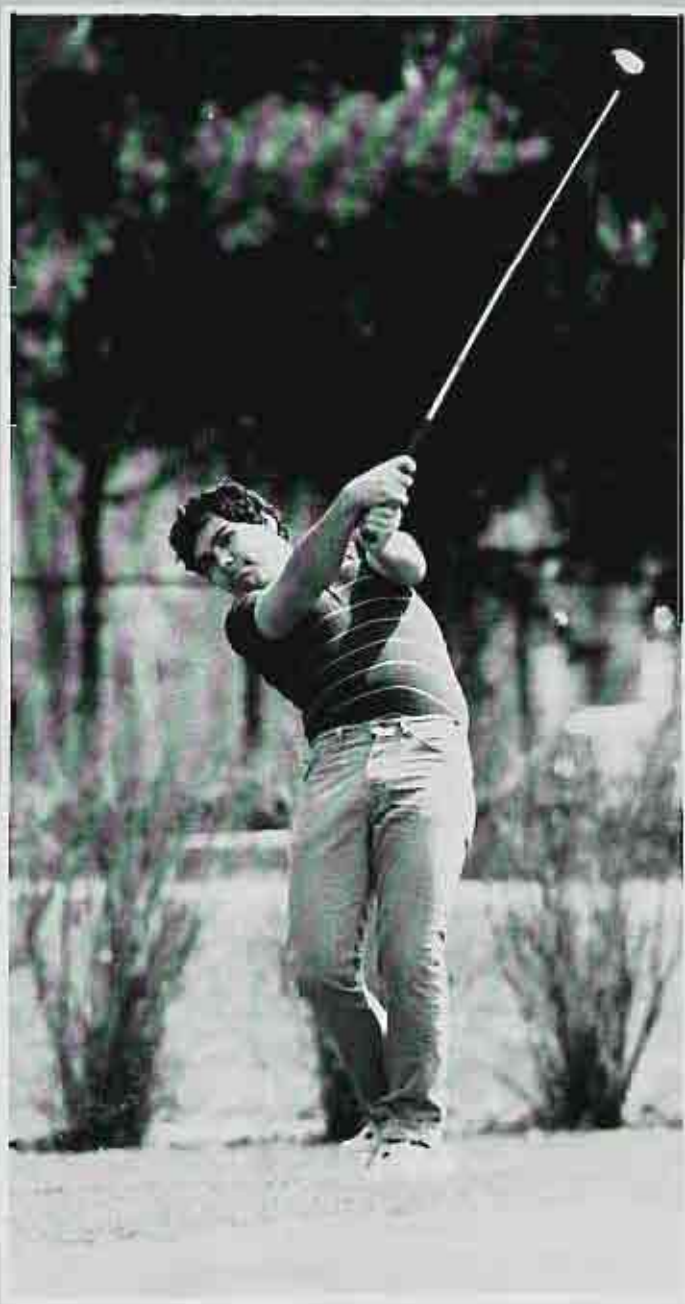
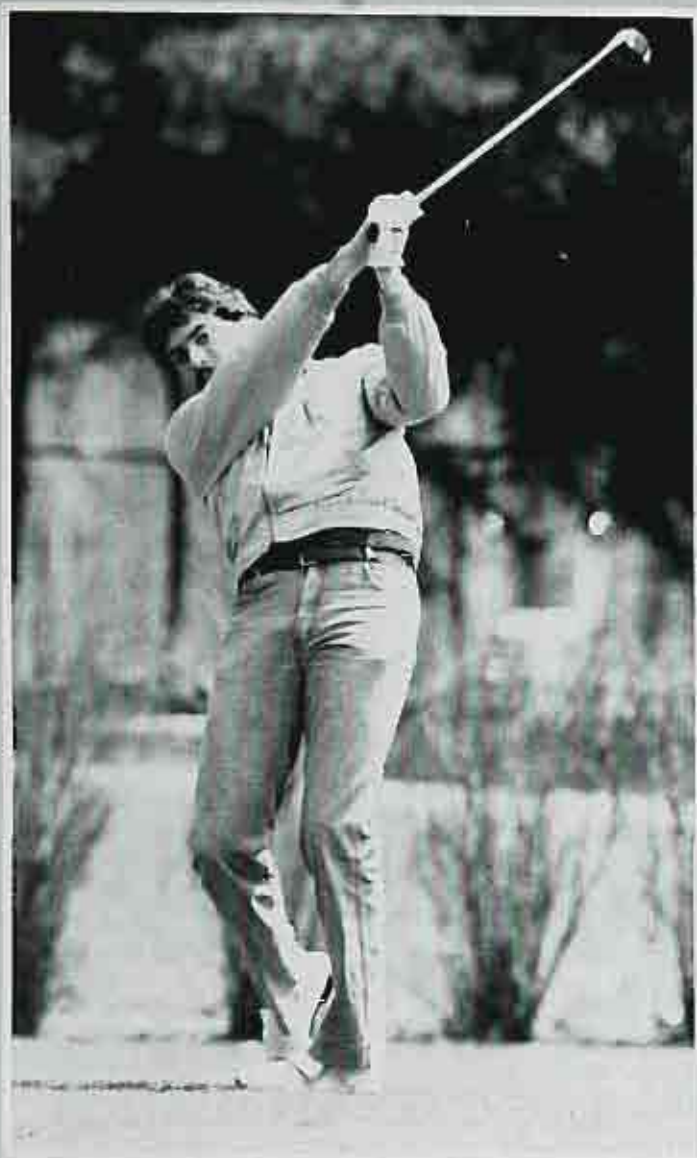














# Softball

## Girls Repeat As Champions

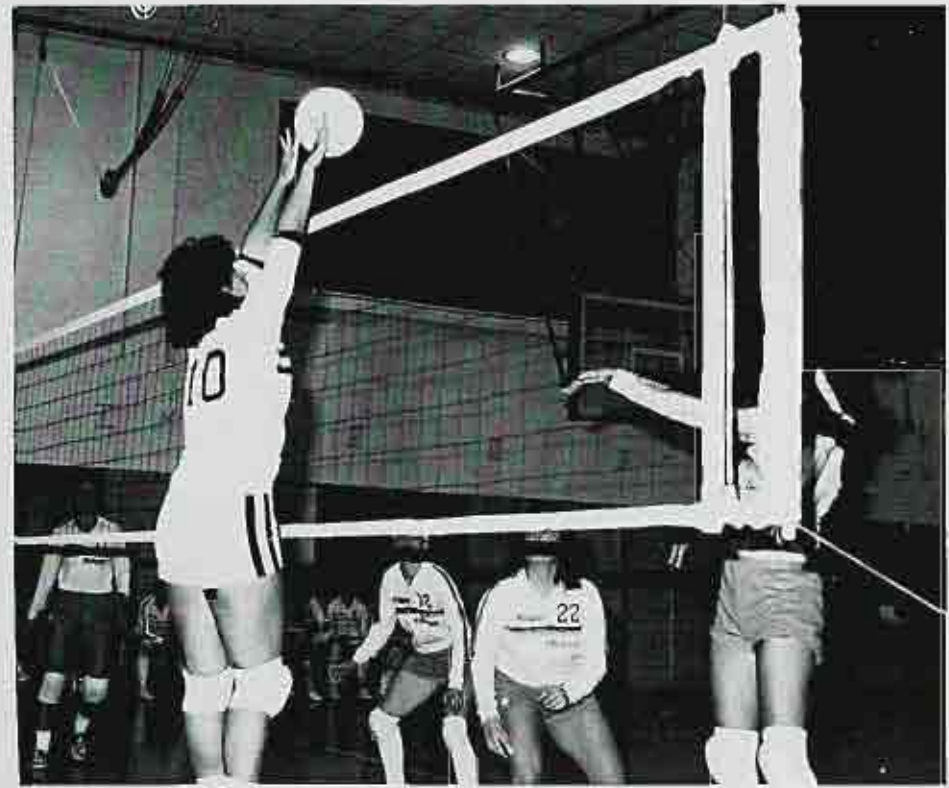

Laurie Kearns, Gwen Masel and Iolene Boenau headed the all-conference team.

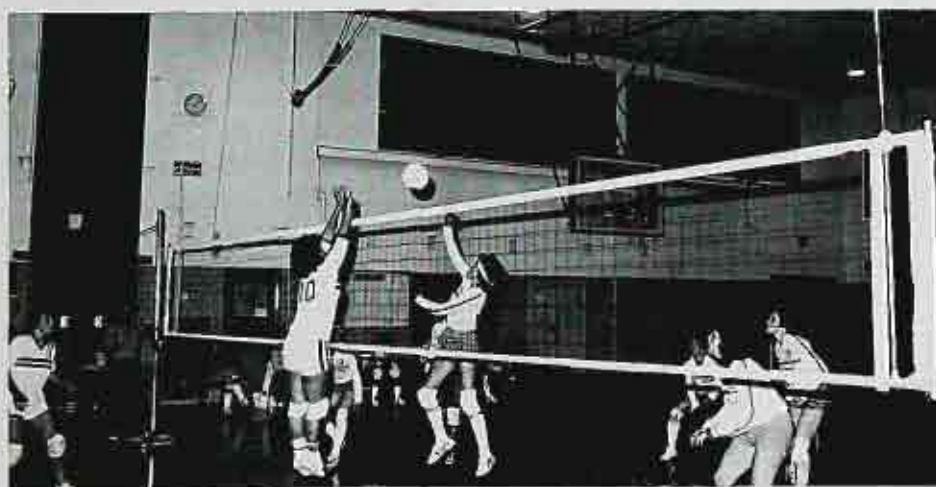














Men's Track

The men's team won 3 of 4 meets during the season while the women were 0-2.

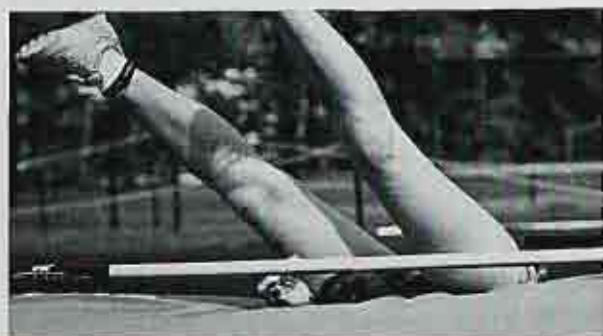

17.

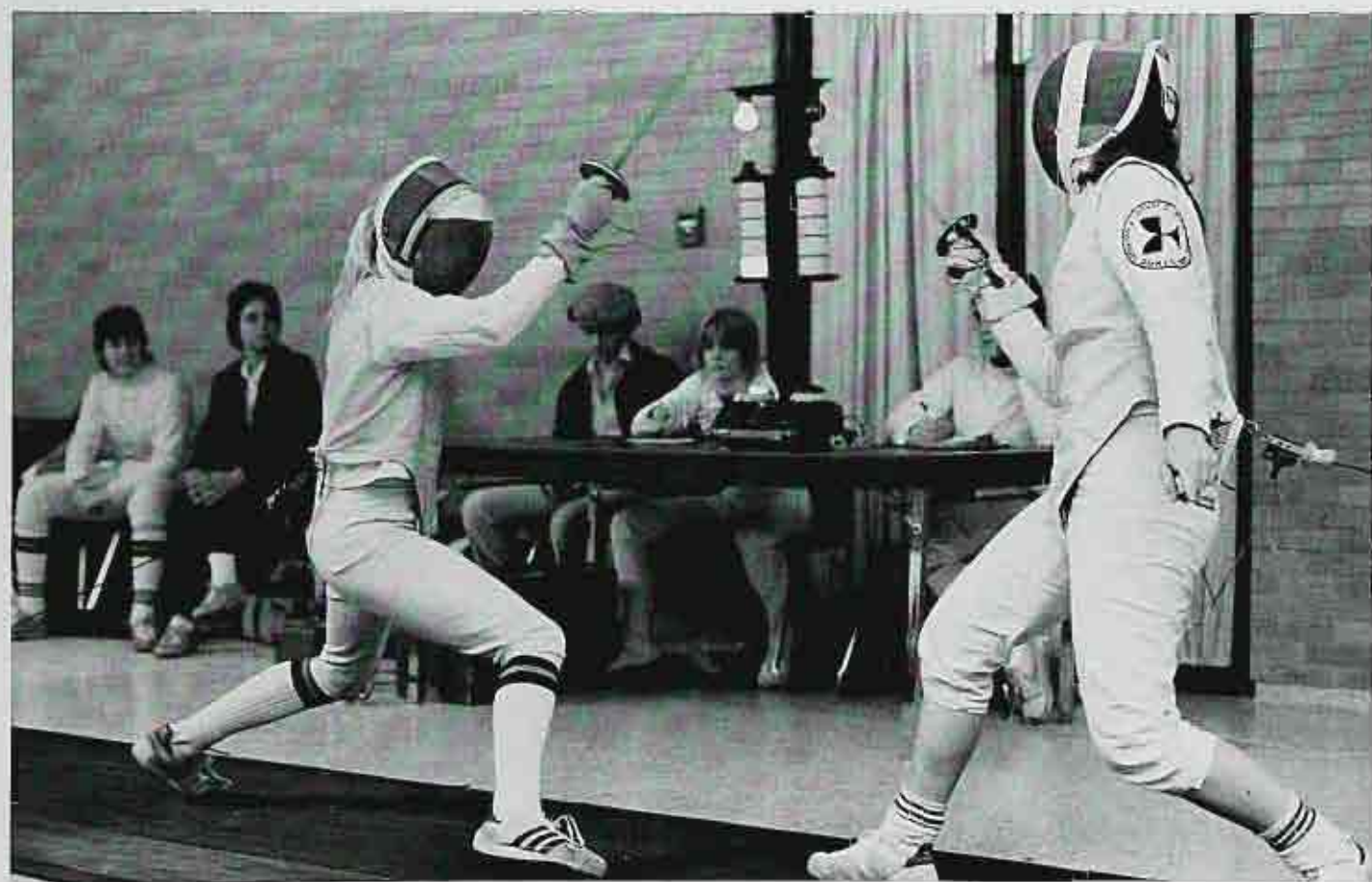

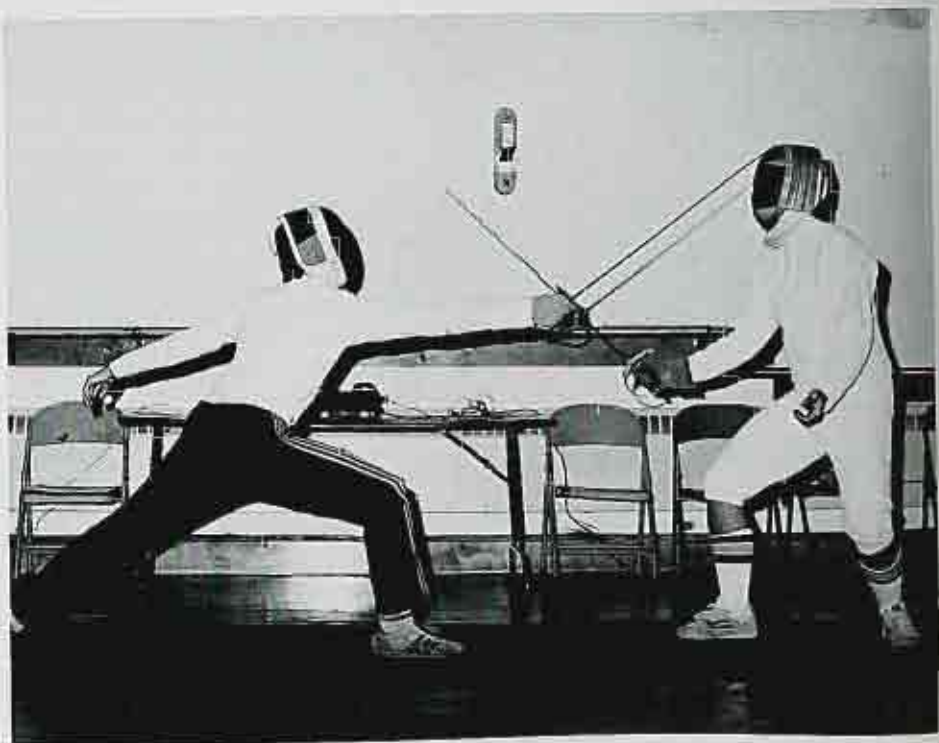
















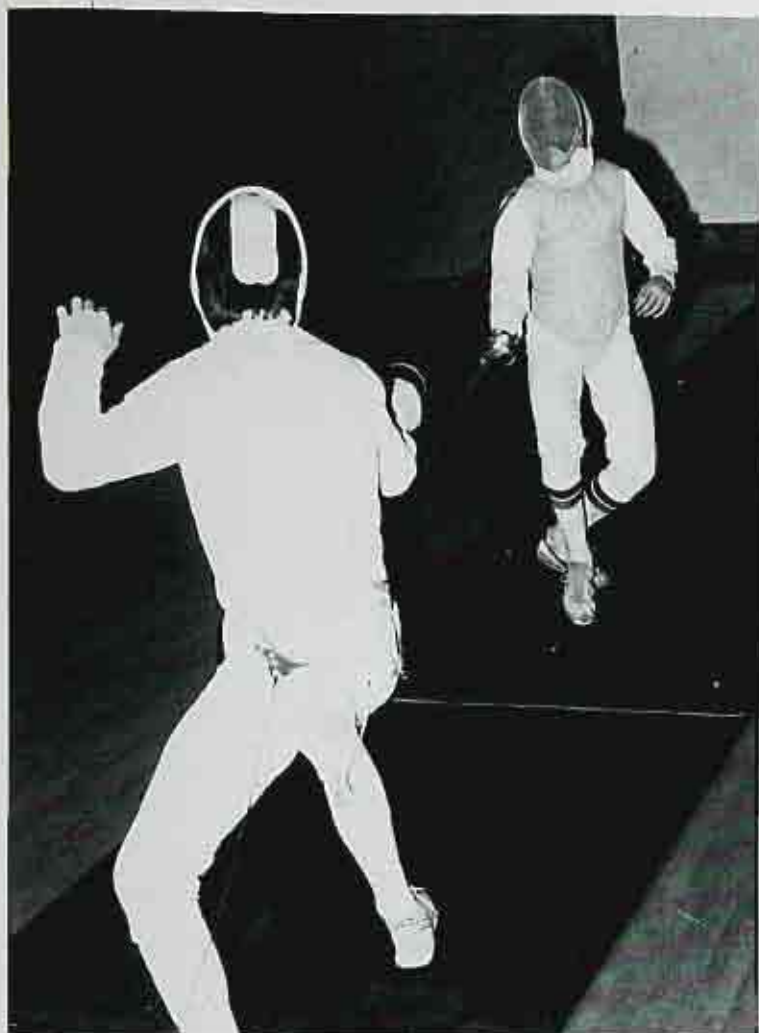
## McLaughlin Earns Third Place In North Atlantic Championships

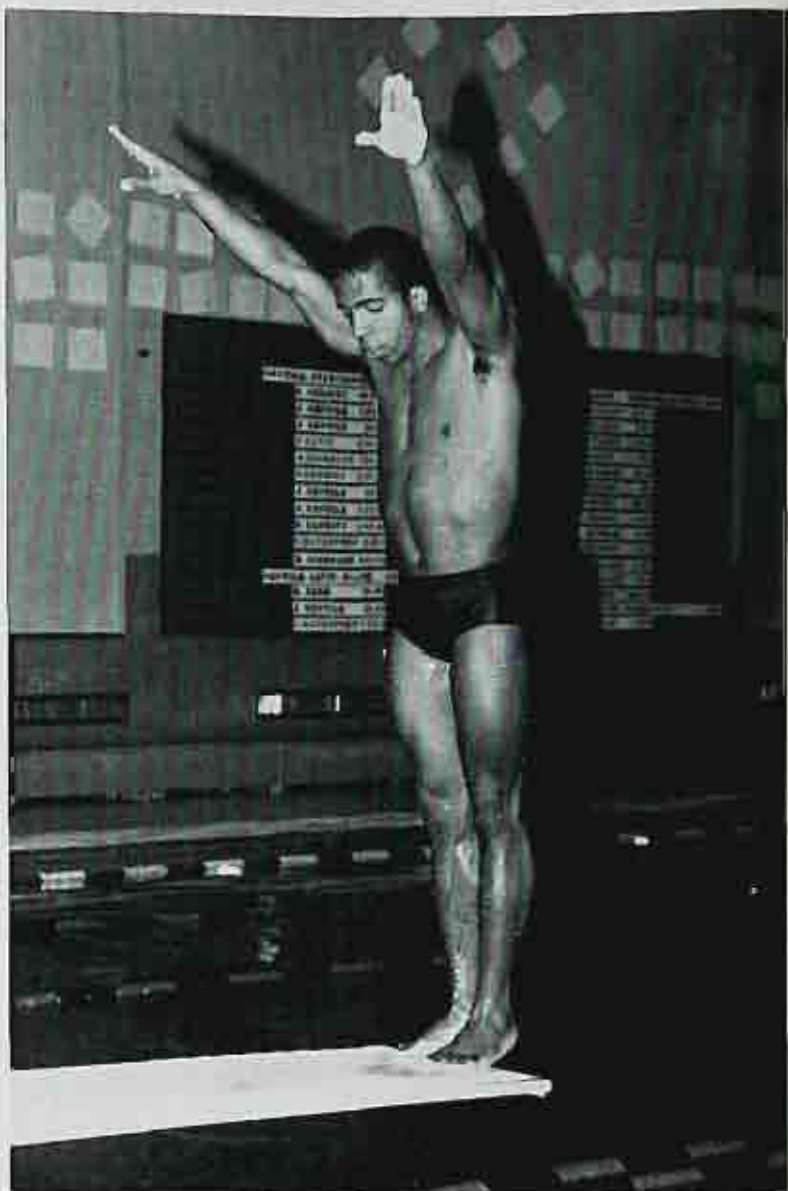
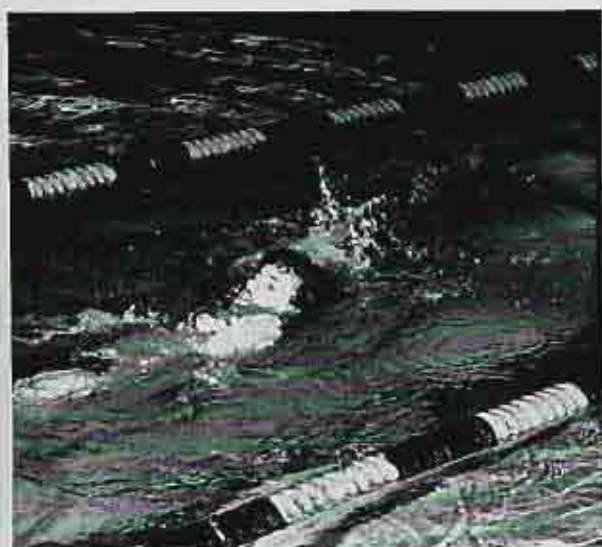








## Swimming

to the record books with a 45-yard field goal against Glassboro, the longest in Pioneer history.

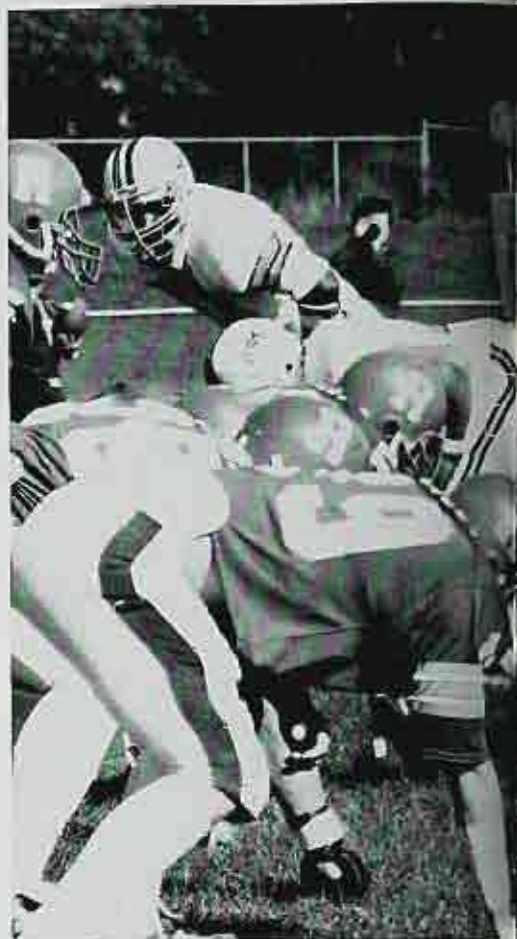
