Jennie Tuttle Hobart

"While her husband served in Washington, Mrs. Hobart was official hostess for Mrs. William McKinley, whose illness often prevented her from entertaining" Morning Call 1/10/41

Esther Jane Tuttle known as Jennie Tuttle Hobart

Mrs. Hobart was a charter member of the Passaic County Historical Society. She had served as honorary president of the Old Ladies' Home in Paterson, in which she was actively interested. She also established a day nursery in Paterson in memory of her daughter. (N.J. Historical Society)

For the great assistance which the Paterson unit contributed to the Belgians, Mrs. Hobart was decorated by King Alfred of the Belgians with the Chevalier de l'ordre Leopold II, the highest decoration of the Belgians. Sept 10, 1932 Pas. Co. Historical Bul

Garret A. Hobart, Jr. born Aug. 31, 1884

Married Caroline Frye Briggs on June 6, 1906

One of five members of Preliminary Park Commission appointed by Justice Black in 1926. He became President in 1931 and served in that capacity until his death

Served for many years as a member of the Board of the Public Library Trustees for Paterson and was a member of the old Paterson Board of Trade Committee

Also Vice President of Paterson Savings Institution and served as a director of the Public Service Corp. of N.J. Historical Proceedings obit & News obit

Died Sept., 29, 1941 (he received the house in 1902 at age 18, married when he was 22

Just 3 generations at Alsa -- 4's daughter Elizabeth Frye Hobart
was married at Alsa Farms 7/20/35 - made her debut at Alsa in 1931
