Papers. William Paterson College is now located on land previously owned by the Hobart Family, heirs to Garret A. Hobart, 24th Vice President of the United States under William McKinley. The papers in the collection include biographical information on family members; information regarding the history and lore of the Hobart Estate, Ailsa Farm and the original manor house; choosing the Hobart Estate as a college site, and the establishment of Paterson State College. There is documentation of the Manor house in relation to its being named an historical site, and information and plans to restore the Manor house to its original grandeur. There are photographs of the exterior and interior of the Manor house.
